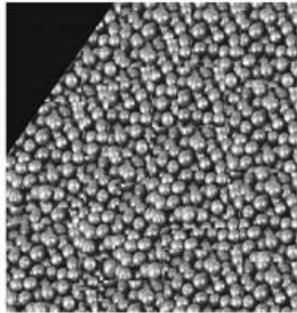

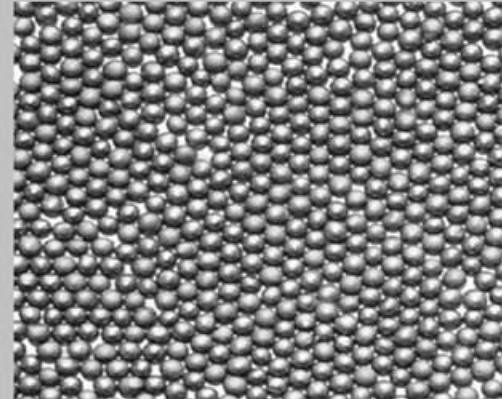
Steel shot is a spherical medium made from annealed, or heat treated, high-carbon steel. An extremely durable and dense medium, it is characterised by its optimum resistance to fatigue and fracture. Steel shot retains its shape during use and is ideal for peening applications. The result of this durability is an efficient and economical abrasive product. Supplied in a range of grades, shot can be used in the majority of airless blast applications. Applications: sand, rust and paint removal, peening, descaling, deflashing, cleaning and pre-coat surface preparation. Suitable for: ferrous and non ferrous metals; natural stone and concrete; structural steel plates and fabrications; castings & forgings; heat treated components.



Steel grit is an angular medium produced by crushing heat treated spherical steel shot pellets. Grit is tougher and more aggressive than steel shot and is available in three different hardness specifications; GN, GL and GH. GN and GL are both suitable for airless and air blast applications and will round off during use, whereas GH will retain its angular shape. GH is the hardest of the 3 grades, is resistant to shattering and is suitable for airblast applications. Applications: pre-coat surface preparation, sand and rust removal, descaling, etching, cleaning, gang-saw stone cutting. Suitable for: foundry applications; structural steel plates, profiles & fabrications; heat treated components; mill rolls; ferrous and non-ferrous forgings & castings; stone surface texturing.



Chilled iron grit is a white iron structure which is produced from carefully selected re-carbonised iron scrap and then crashed into grit. It is an aggressive abrasive medium which shatters on impact rather than wearing round. Chilled iron grit is harder than steel and it cleans at quicker rates. Due to its hardness and performance speed, it is most commonly used in air driven machines to etch structural steel and components prior to paint, metal spray or plastic coating. Applications: cleaning, stripping, descaling, surface preparation, etching, sand and rust and rust removal and gang-saw stone cutting. Suitable for: hard components; steel mill rolls; steel profiles and fabrications; steel castings and forgings.



Stainless Steel shot is a cost effective abrasive medium due to its hardness, longer life and shorter blast time requirement. It leaves a smooth, rust-bloom free spaces and creates less dust than conventional abrasive media. Stainless steel shot can be used in air blast or airless blast applications instead of mild steel shot, glass bead, aluminium oxide, and cut wire. The surface finish obtained using stainless steel shot can eliminate the need for further surface treatments. Applications: cleaning, deburring, deflashing, descaling, pre-coat surface texture and peening. Suitable for: aluminium & zinc die castings; non-ferrous metals and special alloys; stainless steel

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
